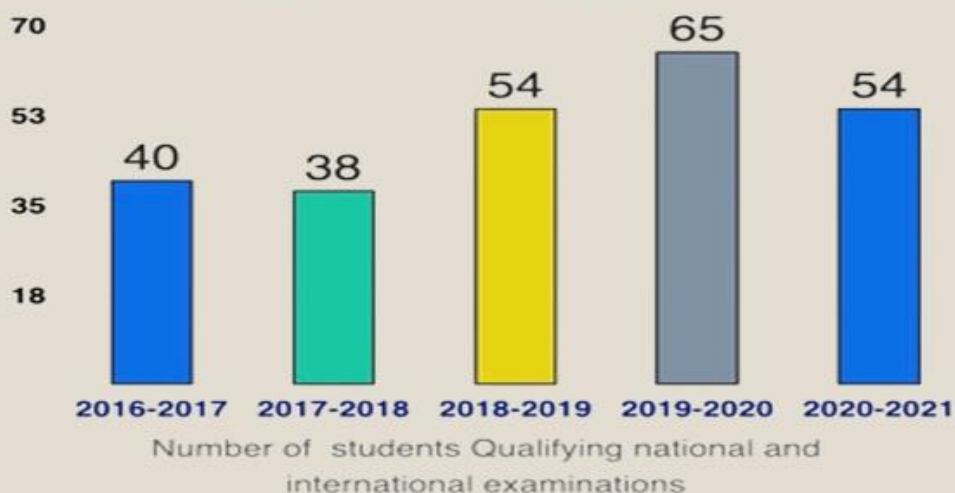

The Universities/Institutions/ Colleges shall **update** the information in the master data (regarding continuation, HRA, up-gradation, resignation etc.) of the beneficiaries on **quarterly** basis. Based on the master data received from the concerned Universities/Institutions/Colleges, the payment of the fellowship will be made to the beneficiaries.

It may also be noted that UGC has proposed to link "**AADHAAR**" with bank account of students so that there can be direct cash transfer and effective disbursement of fellowship into bank account of the student. In this regard, Secretary, UGC had requested the universities to help students in Aadhaar enrolment vide D.O. No. F.14-34/2011 (CPP-II) dated 11.01.2013.
