## History of the College:

Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College is a Government Aided college of West Bengal under the affiliation of the University of Calcutta. The college was established in 1950 as part of a larger historical reality known as the Bengal Partition. The college was founded with the tremendous effort of the suffered, uprooted and struggling people of the erstwhile East Pakistan. To understand the underlying philosophy of this college, the historical background and its location may be briefly outlined. Located in the Jadavpur area, VijaygarhJyotish Ray College is bordered by Saktigarh, Pallisree, Sree Colony, Golf Green and Vikramgarh and covering an area of approximately two square miles. Population within this colony is approximately 25,000. The land was originally a property of the United State Army and a private owner, a Zaminder. The first batch of refugees migrated to be settled in this land in 1946 after a lot of heart wrenching struggle and behind-the- scene negotiations with the government by the veteran freedom fighter Santosh Kumar Dutta who had a land deed to occupy the land.

In order to impart higher education to the youths of this refugee settlement, in June 1950, the first colony committee planned to build a college in the military barrack where this college is now situated. In 21st August, 1950, the owner of this military barrack, the Eastern Command finally agreed to hand over the land to the colony committee to build the college. The college was finally founded in 2nd November, 1950 with Prof. Prasanta Kumar Bose at the helm of the first Governing Body along with many academic stalwarts including Dr. Triguna Sen, Dharendra Nath Roy Chowdhury, Nagendra Nath Pal, Sukumar Gupta and Dr. Makhanlal Roychowdhury. Prof. Mahaswata Debi, Prof. Chinmoy Guha, the legendary academician and researcher in the field of English Literature, nationally and internationally. He became Vice-Chancellor of the Rabindra Bharati University. The college has also been led by many able Principals and Teacher-in-Charge The Present Principal of the college is Dr. Rajyasri Neogy

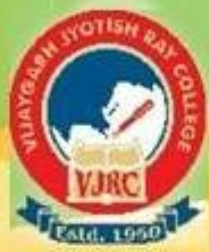

## Rules & Regulation of the College:

**Discipline:** Strict discipline is maintained within the college campus. Soling the wall of the college building by posterage etc., loitering in the corridors, disturbing the neighbouring classes, causing damage to or loss of college property, misbehaving with college staff, either teaching or non-teaching misbehaving with students, trying to do anything which may be detrimental to the academic interest of the students etc. are regards as acts of breach of discipline and any student found guilty of committing them will be severely punished. The entire procedure is supervised by the Cell headed by a senior professor.

**Administration:** The college administration is led by the Principal/Teacher-In-Charge at the helm coordinating and integrating the Governing Body, Teacher, Non-teaching Staff and the students into an administrative whole. A spirit of co-operation is evident among the guardians who are periodically informed of the attendance and performed of their wards. That the college is on its way to realize its potential for continuous progress is marked by its growth-quantitative as well as qualitative.

**General Rules:** The academic session beings in the month of July and continues till the month of June of the next year. Admission to all classes is made strictly on merit. The choice of stream, offering of subjects, change of stream etc. Strictly conform to the guidelines laid down by University of Calcutta. Attention of the Students is drawn to the following general instructions:-

1. All Applications for admission to any class in the college are to be made online through the college website and application fees are to be submitted in any branch of Canara Bank. The admission fees are to be submitted at Canara Bank, Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College branch. The required documents for admission are to be submitted to the college offices by the specified dates between 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on all working days for the only selected candidates, the list of whose names is put up on the college website in due time.
2. The cash counter of the college remains open from 11 am to 2pm(day) and 5-30 pm to 8-30 pm (for evening shift) on all working days except Saturday and the first and the last working days of the month.
3. Change of Subject / course may be allowed as per rules of the University of Calcutta, within one month from the date of commencement of the concerned class.
4. All applications of the students addressed to the Principal/TIC must come through the Head Assistant of the college office.
5. Railway concession Certificates, Character certificates etc. will be issued to the students three days after the date of submission of applications made to the college authority.
6. A candidate may seek refund of his Laboratory / Library caution deposits after completion of the course of studies. Only 50% of the Laboratory caution deposit amount will be refunded.
7. Every student must see the college Notice Board to keep himself/herself abreast of all the information circulated through various notices issued by the college from time to time.
8. Students are to produce the fee books at the time of taking delivery of their Admit Cards. Registration Certificates. Mark Sheets and Pass -certificates of the final examinations.
9. Every student must see the notice board every day.





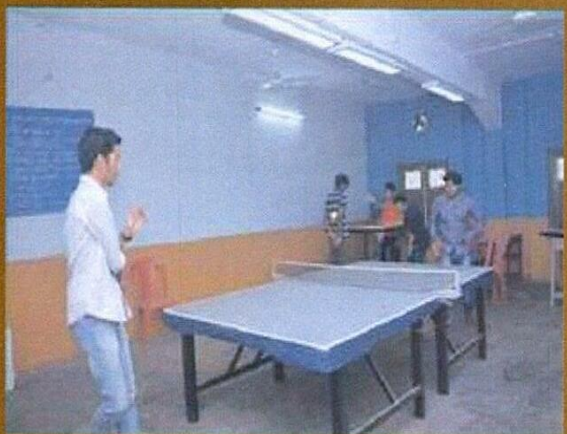

## Distance Education (RabindraBharati University) DDE:

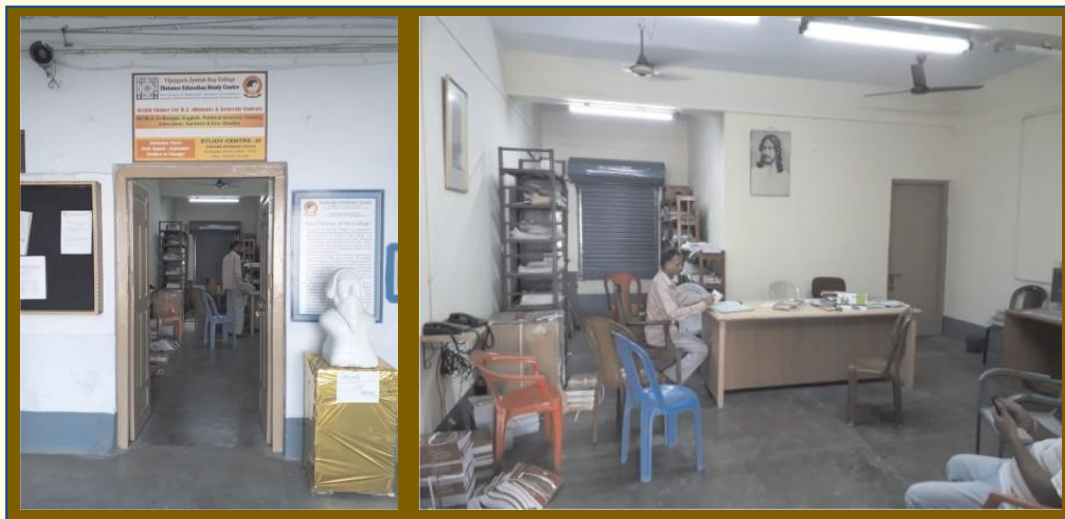

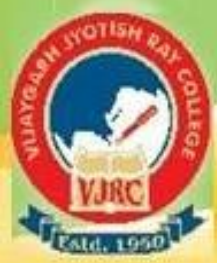

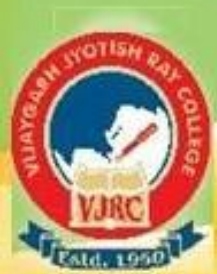

### Attendance of Students:

1. A student attending at least 75% of the total number of classes \*held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned semester examination subject to fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the regulation.
2. A student attending 60% but less than 75% of the total number of classes\* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned semester examination subject to the payment of prescribed condo nation fees and fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the regulation.
3. A student attending at least 60% of the total number of classes " held shall not be allowed to appear at the concerned semester examinations and he/she has to pursue admission to the same semester in the very next year for attending the classes and appearing at the said semester examination.

5. The college will not be responsible if the University does not sanction migration to such candidates and in such cases the provisional admission stands cancelled.

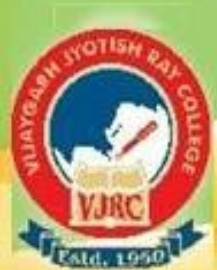

## General Rules and Regulations for Admission in P.G. (Microbiology):

*The Regulations for the Two-year M.Sc. course in Microbiology, Vijoygarh Jyotish Ray College (affiliated to university of Calcutta)*

1. The Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College shall provide instructions leading two year M.sc biology.
2. A candidate who has passed the 3-year B.Sc. Examination with Honours in Microbiology will be eligible for admission to this course.
3. A limited number of seats, at par with the UGC guidelines, will be available to the non-C.U. candidates. The students. However, will have to satisfy the same eligibility criteria applicable to the students of University of Calcutta.
4. The duration of the courses shall be two academic years and the examination for the M Sc degree in Microbiology shall be held over four semesters over a total of 1000 marks. The duration of the semesters shall be as follows:

1st Semester: July -December  
3rd Semester: July - December

2nd Semester: January-June  
4th Semester: January-June

The Common Research Facility Centre in the college was established in 2003 with an aim to encourage the post graduate students to take up scientific research as career. The centre harbors high end instruments like Fluor meter. Phase contrast microscope, CO<sub>2</sub> incubator and Animal Cell Culture facilities besides basic instruments for carrying out research activities.

Projects founded by DBT, DST and BARNS are currently under way at the centre. The major thrust area of research at the centre is development of co-ordination metal complex as anti-Leishmanial agent and development of microbial media for culturing parasite. Outcomes of research at the centre have been published in several international journals. One fellow from the centre has been already awarded with her Ph.D. degree and one is carrying out her research for doctor ate degree in Microbiology. Overall the centre has been serving as a hub for active research over years.
