1. OBJECTIVES:

It has been observed that the students of remote area and with average merit and willing to go for higher education but is in no scope for availing the Post Graduation course for the insufficient number of institutions providing this course the appropriate authority of the college took initiative to introduce the study centre to facilitate the students to attend the PG course under RABINDRA BHARATI UNIVERSITY in distance mode. That is, the motto of this study centre is to disseminate the knowledge in remote areas of West Bengal and of course specially for the students passing out from this college.

4. ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY

Admission Eligibility:

i. M.A. in Bengali, English, History, Political Science, Education Honours / General / Pass (minimum 10+2+3) in the Subject concerned having the relevant Subject of minimum 300 full marks at Graduate level from any UGC recognized institutions in India or abroad.

ii. M.A. in Environmental Studies Honours / General / Pass / Equivalent Graduate (minimum 10+2+3) / Post Graduate in General or Professional Course from any UGC recognized institutions in India or abroad.

iii. M.A. in Education

B. Ed. or B.Ed. (special education) from any UGC recognized institutions in India along with Honours / General / Pass (minimum 10+2+3) from any UGC recognized institutions in India or abroad. Or, Honours / General / Pass (minimum 10+2+3) in Education, having minimum 300 full marks at Graduate level from any UGC recognized Institutions.

iv. Points to Note --

All Subjects are offered for Study at the Main Campus (Learner Support Centre Code-99), Rabindra Bhavan, Salt Lake, Kolkata. –

Subjects offered for study at various Learner Support Centres (LSC) are given in the prospectus. –

(Social Work, Rabindra Sangeet, and Vocal Music are offered only at Main Campus, Salt Lake (LSC-99).

5. ADMISSION PROCEDURE (conducted centrally by university)

Online form fill-up for admission is done by the notifications that are available on the website from time to time. –

Admission of the candidate is confirmed after thorough verification of the original testimonials like Admit Cards, Mark Sheets, Grade Cards, Certificates etc. to be produced at the respective Learner Support Centre (LSC) / Study Centre and subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria. –

Date of verification of the original testimonials Is notified in due course on the University website at www.rbudde.in.

Students are required to complete verification within stipulated date and time failing which the candidature stands cancelled. – Admission of candidate stand cancelled if he / she fails to produce original Admit Cards, Marksheets, Grade Cards, and Certificates etc. at the time of verification. – Identity card issued after confirmation of admission – If found ineligible later on, admission of the candidate will be cancelled.

6. Procedure of Online Admission and Making Payment

The admission process is done online centrally through CDOE website (www.rbudde.in) on first-come- first-serve basis.

Candidates seeking admission to the Learner Support Centres (LSC) under RBU, CDOE will have to visit the CDOE website www.rbudde.in and follow the steps for online application for admission and fees payment. Payment of fees can be made only through payment gateway using Debit/Credit Cards or Net Banking. After submission of application form online, candidate will be required to submit the hard copy of downloaded application form along with copies of testimonials like Admit Cards, Marksheets, Grade Cards, Certificates etc. and payment receipt and produce the respective original testimonials for verification at respective Learner Support Centre (LSC). The date of submission of the hard copy of downloaded application form and verification of the testimonials is notified in due time.

7. Structure of Semester System with CBCS: (framed by RABINDRA BHARATI UNIVERSITY, DDE)

In distance mode of learning, the University offers the same structure of Semester system under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) followed in regular mode of learning, consisting of three types of courses viz. Core Course, Compulsory Elective Course and Open Elective Course. However, in distance learning mode, structure of semester system under the post-graduate academic programmes (Master's Degree) as recommended by the respective Subject Committee of the Department under the faculties of Arts and Fine Arts may vary from time to time as per decision of the University subject to approval of the UGC, DEB. Core Course (CC):

This is a set of courses which is considered essential to any suitable educational programme of the University to develop necessary knowledge, in-depth understanding and ability to apply concerned skills among the students in a specific discipline. The learning components of the courses should be determined according to the international and national standards, Vision and Mission of the University as well as according to the common requirement in context of the society. Total number of Core Courses is 6 having of 5 credits for each course for the subjects of Bengali, English, Education, Political Science, Environmental Studies, History under Faculty of Arts of Core Course is

7a. Compulsory Elective Course (CEC): This is a pool of specialized courses based on different emerging areas under the broad domain of the discipline, but beyond the compulsory courses; from which one area of specialization be opted by the students for nurturing self-development, self-fulfilment and skill development. Total number of Compulsory Elective Courses is 4 having of 5 credits for each course for the subjects of Bengali, English, Education, Political Science, Environmental Studies, History under Faculty of Arts of 5 credits for each course.

Open Elective Course (OEC): This is a pool of specialized courses having multi-disciplinary character.

It may be related with the mother discipline of study and may be supportive to the discipline of study enabling an exposure to some other discipline or domain of studies. Open Elective Courses may be offered to the students of other departments including the students of home department to choose one Elective Course containing two courses in the Semester IV out of the pool of Open Elective Courses. Total number of Open Elective Courses is 2 having of 5 credits for each course for the subjects of Bengali, English, Education, Political Science, Environmental Studies, History under Faculty of Arts, Structure of Semester system under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for M.A. in Bengali, English, Education, Political Science, Environmental Studies, History under Faculty of Arts.

8. TEACHING- LEARNING PROCESS:

Students are provided SELF LEARNING MATERIALS (SLM) by the main campus and also is uploaded the same by the University in student portal.

Classes are generally conducted by the hybrid system of both ON-LINE and OFF-LINE MODE. As per guidelines of university classes in nature of PCP (PERSONAL COUNSELLING PROGRAMME) are held mainly on SUNDAY and Holidays amounting in all to 48 hrs. in each semester. The main objective of this PCP is to clear the doubts of the chapters by the way of interaction process.

At the end of PCP model questions are provided by the main campus for justifying the self -study report which is prepared by the students on the basis of the term end questions which are provided by the main centre. The counsellors of LSC examine the submitted the self -assigned answer scripts and the marks awarded is treated as internal assessment marks without which no student will be allowed to appear the end semester examination.

Students submit SRS according to the schedule fixed by the main campus. The submitted assignment is examined by the concerned teachers and return the same to the students after appropriate comment for corrective action.

Counselling is conducted by the efficient and experienced teachers.

Students' progression:

Examination is processed and conducted centrally by the Rabindra Bharati University (DDE) through home away centres.

Reviewing the performance of the students it is found that about 90% students enrolled appeared in end semester examination and more than 95% of the appeared students completed their Master Degree in their respective subject.

*** RBU temporarily suspended the subjects as marked xxxx centrally due to some administrative problems of the university and of course it was reintroduced from 2022 again.

Administration:-

The study centre is administered by a body of administration consisting of PRINCIPAL (ex-officio), Coordinator and two office assistants. Policies as framed and circulated by the main Campus is executed by the body of administration under the chairmanship of Principal.

STRONG points of this STUDY centre are to facilitate the students to have the counselling by efficient counsellors. PCP classes are held at regular interval. Counsellors are very much academic friendly in Students' WhatsApp group.

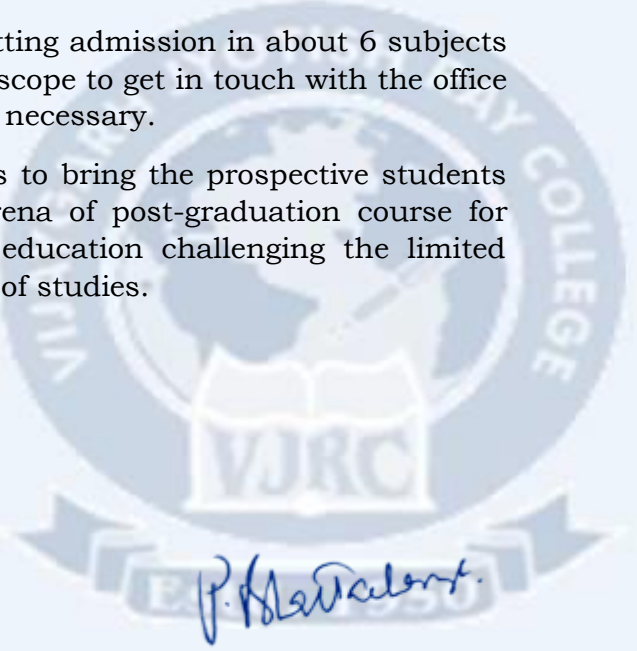
The WEAK points are that the study centre has the constraint to run by the policies of main campus and due to space problem library for the students of distance education could not be provided.
